## Assistant professor position in bio-materials

The Department of Mechanics at École Polytechnique invites applications for a faculty position at the Assistant Professor level in biomaterials, starting September 1st, 2021.

Candidates must hold a PhD and have a track record of excellent research and teaching. They are expected to teach courses in mechanics at different levels (Bachelor, Engineering school and Master) as well as specialized courses in biomaterials, and to contribute to the department's course offer at both the undergraduate and graduate levels.

The candidate will conduct original research in biomaterials, preferably experimentally. Areas of interest include multi-scale (micro to nano) biological materials, bioengineering, cellular/tissue engineering, or biological gels and polymers. Candidates interested in collaborating directly with physicians are especially encouraged to apply. The selected candidate will conduct original research within the laboratory of solid mechanics of the Ecole Polytechnique (LMS) and the Interdisciplinary Biomedical Engineering (BME) Program. The BME Program centralizes Ecole Polytechnique's activities in this field. Program faculty members are affiliated with various campus departments including Physics, Mechanics, Biology, and Applied Mathematics. The candidate should submit a complete CV along with a research project and a teaching statement with their application.

In terms of responsibilities, duties, and salary, Assistant Professor positions at École Polytechnique are equivalent to the French academic positions of "Maître de Conférences".
